

## Laboratory Instructions for Unique Ordering

- 1. PAS <u>DON'T</u> register patient in any system. Notify phlebotomist of patient arrival.
- 2. Order in <u>Cerner</u> (OSM Requisition Order Entry) <u>DON'T USE EPIC</u> for registration or ordering.
- 3. Use HDVCH Nephrology/Transplant (Client #1101) in OSM ROE to find patient and encounter.
- 4. Find patient and select the encounter with the *Episode of Care FIN* that is listed in Patient Information section below. This won't be a lab encounter, but should be used. <u>DON'T</u> create a new encounter.
- 5. Order tests in Cerner that are marked below in the Tests section. <u>DON'T</u> combine tests into panels.
- 6. If blood is being collected at Spectrum Health outpatient laboratory location, also add an order for Blood Draw Charge (test #198) in Cerner on the encounter with the Episode of Care FIN.
